## **Mobile Phones**

#### Student use of personal devices at school:

All students are required to keep their personal devices 'off and away' between the start and end of each school day and while they are attending authorised school activities off-site, such as camps and excursions.

Students may only access their personal devices during these times if they have received an approved <u>exemption</u> from their school to use the device for a specific, agreed reason.

Access refers to both physical access, including wearing any wearable technology that fits the definition of personal devices in this policy, and remote access, such as connecting other technology to the personal device's hotspot or using headphones that are paired to the personal device.

## National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence

### Growing connections for the National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence

Friday 18 August 2023, is the National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence (NDA). Melaleuca Park Primary school will be participating on the 17 August 2023 so that all the classes are able to join in.

The NDA is Australia's key bullying prevention initiative for schools and provides an opportunity to connect with students, staff and our school community to implement workable solutions to prevent bullying.

The 2023 NDA theme, Growing Connections, promotes the importance of school, family and community connections in building sage and supportive learning environments where all student scan belong, feel accepted and respected.

Research has shown that strong school connections and positive relationships can help to prevent bullying. When students feel a sense of belonging and connectedness at school, they are more likely to enjoy school, to trust and respect their teachers, and be concerned about help others (Australian Education Research Organisation 2023).


At Melaleuca Park Primary school, we will help grow connections by buddying up the Senior School classes with the Junior School classes for shared Discovery sessions, promoting inclusiveness, respect and community belonging for all students. Students will also participate in a range of activities during the week addressing different ways of preventing and responding to bullying.

It is important for our whole-school community, including our staff, parents, carers and students to have a clear understanding of the definition of bullying to be able to correctly identify and respond to incidents of bullying.
